# Immigrants: Knowledge is Power, Protect Your Rights!

# Don't Panic, Get Informed, and Don't Get Scammed!

During the 2016 presidential campaign, President-elect Donald Trump pledged to crack down on immigration, deport millions of undocumented immigrants, build a wall along the U.S.-Mexico border, and end the 2012 <u>Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) initiative</u>. Though <u>statements on President-elect Trump's campaign website support these ideas</u>, the timing and scope of any changes to current policies are unclear.

Until more information is known, you can take steps now to protect yourself by understanding your rights and learning the truth.
